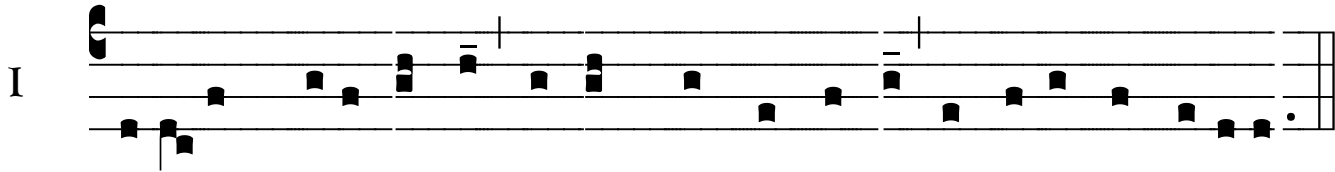


# Psalm 27

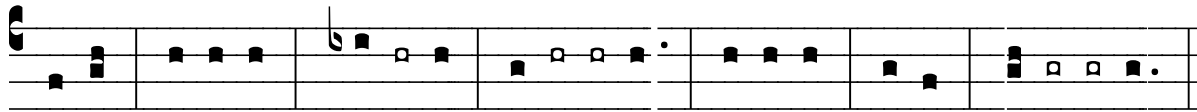
Masses for the Dead, Lectionary 1013-3
