Therefore my heart is glad and my soul re-joices, my body, too, abides in confidence; because you



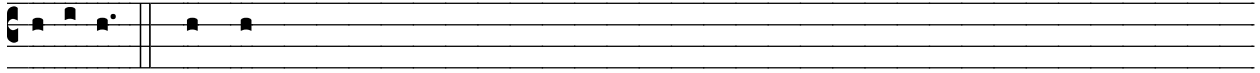
will not a-bandon my soul to the netherworld, nor will you suffer your faithful one to undergo
