


# Responsorial Psalm


for the Twenty-second Sunday in Ordinary Time / Year A

Psalm 63:(2b) 2, 3-4, 5-6, 8-9; Tone III g<sup>2</sup>


My soul is thirst - ing for you, O Lord my God.
