


Antiphon for use outside of Lent:



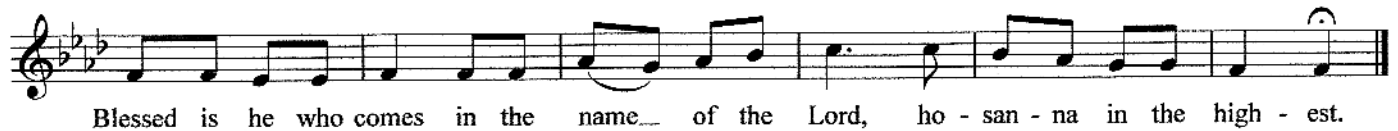

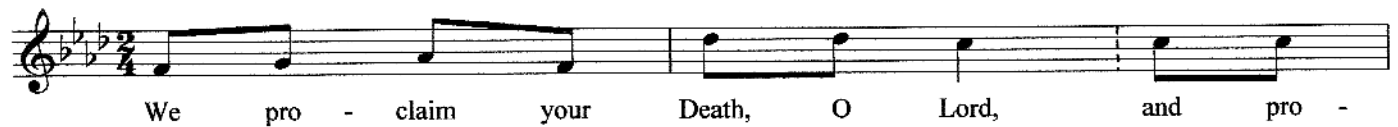
