b) Simple Tone.

This tone is used for the Prayers of the Aspersion, of the Blessings, of the Litanies, and for other Prayers of the same kind, except those which are preceded by Flectámus génua.

If this simple tone be adopted, it is used also for the Prayer Super populum. after the admonition Humiliate capita vestra. (as on p. 99).

As a general rule, the flex is made at the first sub-division; it is, however, omitted if the Prayer is very short. The metrum, on the other hand, is never omitted.
