
The NOH 1950s Volume No. 1 lacks pages 348-349.

We do not possess these, and never have. The following pages are from the 1940s edition of the NOH, but these cannot substitute for the 1950s for the following three reasons:


- (1) Psalm 150 does not match because the 1950s version ("Laudate Dominum in sanctuario ejus") employs the Pius XII Psalter, whereas the 1940s version ("Laudate Dominum in sanctis ejus") uses the Traditional Psalter;
- (2) The 1950s Antiphon ("Et Valde Mane") does not correspond to the 1940s Antiphon ("Vespere Autem Sabbati") because they come from different parts of the Divine Office;
- (3) The 1950s text ("Benedictus") for the Antiphon is the Canticle of Zachary, not the 1940s "Magnificat," for the same reason. But at least the 1940s version includes the "Ite Missa Est," whereas the 1950s edition forces you to get that from Volume 5.





