

HOLY THURSDAY

(Goupil p. 175) INTROIT “Nos Autem” • Sung during the procession by the men

The Prayers at the Foot of the Altar are said on Holy Thursday, mean while the Choir sings:

(Binder) KYRIE #6995 by Palestrina

(Binder) GLORIA #7709 by Viadana

(Goupil p. 177) GRADUAL “Christus Factus Est” • Sung by the men who practiced

No Credo on Holy Thursday. (“Today, the Credo is omitted”)

After the Sermon, comes the Mandatum (“Washing of the feet”). During that, the choir will sing :

(Goupil p. 178 & p. 179 & p. 181) • Antiphon III • *Sung by the ladies w/ Men doing verses*
+ Ubi Caritas + Responses

“After the Mandatum, Mass is continued in the usual way” *Dominus vob...*

(Goupil p. 182) Offertory Antiphon, as usual (Men start, women follow)

(Binder) Offertory Hymn • #3316 • “Herzliebster Jesu”

(Binder) Sanctus & Hosanna • Palestrina #6962

(Binder) AGNUS DEI • **Today, the response each time is: “miserere nobis.”**
#4347 by Du Fay.

(Binder) Communion Polyphony • #7128 *Verbum Supernum* (SATB).

(Goupil p. 184) Communion Antiphon • *Sung by the ladies w/ Men doing verses*

Mass continues very much as usual (Ablutions, etc.) and there IS a Post-Communion
— Response to “Benedicamus Domino” is “Deo Gratias”

Immediately after Mass there is a procession. If it is long, “other hymns, psalms, or canticles may be sung.” We sing the Tantum Ergo, exclusive of the final two verses:

(Goupil p. 186) Procession • Pange Lingua • starting pitch = E
#178 in Campion Missal
