2. Yet he commanded the *clouds above*, * and opened the gates *of* heaven.


He rained down man*na to* eat, * and gave them bread *from* heaven.

The angel of the LORD *is encamped* * around those who fear him, *to* **res**cue them.


4. When the just cry out, *the LORD* hears, * and rescues them in all their *distress*.
