We praise you, we bless you, we a-dore you, we glo-ri-fy you, we give you thanks for your great glo-ry, Lord God, heav'n-ly King, O God, almighty Father. Lord Je-sus Christ, Only you take Be-gotten Son, Lord God, Lamb of God, Son of the Father, away the sins of the world, have mercy on us; you take a-way the sins of the world, receive our prayer; you are seated at the right hand of the Father, have mercy on us. For you a-lone are the Ho-ly One, you a-lone are the Lord, you a-lone are the Most High, Je-sus Christ, with the Ho-ly Spir-it, in the glo-ry of God the Father. A- men.
