A THOUGHT FOR SUNDAY

We look at the constitutive parts of something in order to observe its quality or excellence. We do this in our daily life, comparing capacity and speed of a computer or phone, comfort and materials of a sofa, and so on. Something with more and greater features is going to be better than something with less.

Considered in this light, the Rosary is truly a phenomenal prayer. Fifty three times we remind Our Mother of Her happiest day - repeating the salutation of the Angel, followed by the salutation of St Elizabeth and then ask our Mother to pray for us sinners both now, and when we need it most: at death.

These are grouped into sets of ten, each prefaced with the prayer to the Heavenly Father that Our Lord

Himself taught us, and concluded with the prayer that proclaims glory to the Trinity.

Each one of these sets of ten, - “decades” is what we call them - is dedicated to a mystery out of Our Lord’s life, which in some way is related to Our Blessed Mother.

Finally this entire prayer is prefaced by our Creed and concluded with the Salve.

Some people pray the Rosary because of what they get out of it - which is abundant. However in spite of all that we receive from the Rosary, it is the greatest tribute we can give to Our Blessed Mother.
