**W**hile you stand for 45 minutes listening to the Passion being chanted today, it is a good time to reflect.

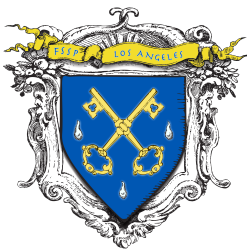

# WHY PLEDGE?



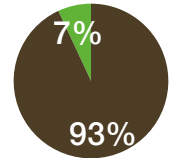
The Founders Campaign is to raise money to purchase our future church.
