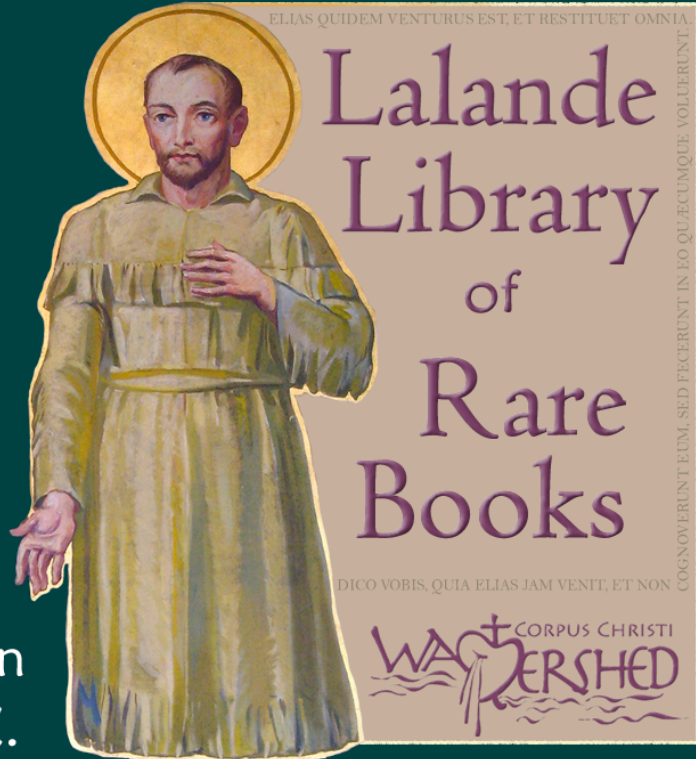

# ON MAUNDY THURSDAY

When the Mass is ended a Procession is made, during which is sung the Hymn Pange lingua gloriosi (English Hymnal 93).

After the Procession is finished, Evensong is said in Choir, without any singing.

Then the altars are laid bare, after which the Ministers come together to perform the Maundy.

First the Prelate or Superior among the Clergy sings in the customary manner the Gospel. During that which follows the nine Anthems given below are sung.
