Univérsi qui te exspéctant, \* non confundéntur, Dómine.  
℣ Vias tuas, Dómine, notas fac mihi: \* et sémitas tuas édoce me.

## 2nd Sunday of Advent (ABC)

Ex Sion spécies decórís ejus: \* Deus maniféste véniet.  
℣ Congregáte illi sanctos ejus, \* qui ordinavérunt testaméntum ejus super sacrificia.

## Immaculate Conception of the BVM

Benedícta es tu, Virgo María, a Dómino Deo excélsō, \* prae ómnibus muliéribus super terram.  
℣ Tu glória Jerúsalem, tu laetítia Israel, \* tu honorificéntia pópuli nostri.

## 3rd Sunday of Advent (AC)

Qui sedes, Dómine, super Chérubim, \* excita poténtiam tuam, et veni.  
℣ Qui regis Israel, inténde: \* qui dedúcis velut ovem Joseph.

## 3rd Sunday of Advent (B)

Fuit homo missus a Deo, cui nomen Joánnes erat: \* hic venit.  
℣ Ut testimónium perhibéret de lúmine, \* et paráre Dómino plebum perféctam.

## 4th Sunday of Advent (ABC)

Prope est Dóminus ómnibus invocántibus eum: \* ómnibus qui ínvocant eum in veritáte.  
℣ Laudem Dómini loquéatur os meum: \* et benedícat omnis caro nomen sanctum ejus.

## 1st Sunday of Advent (ABC)

For all they that look for thee \* shall not be ashamed, O Lord.  
℣ Make known unto me thy ways, O Lord: \* and teach me thy paths.

## 2nd Sunday of Advent (ABC)

Out of Zion hath God appeared \* in perfect beauty.  
℣ Gather my saints together unto me: \* those that have made a covenant with me with sacrifice.

## Immaculate Conception of the BVM

Blessed art thou, O Virgin Mary, of the Lord, the most high God, \* above all women upon earth.  
℣ Thou art the glory of Jerusalem, thou art the joy of Israel: \* thou art the rejoicing of our nation.

## 3rd Sunday of Advent (AC)

Show thyself, O Lord, thou that sittest upon the Cherubim, \* stir up thy strength and come.  
℣ Hear, O thou Shepherd of Israel: \* thou that leadest Joseph like a sheep.

## 3rd Sunday of Advent (B)

There was a man sent from God, whose name was John. \* This man has come.  
℣ To give testimony of the light \* and to prepare unto the Lord a perfect people.

## 4th Sunday of Advent (ABC)

The Lord is night unto all them that call upon him: \* yea, all such as call upon him faithfully.  
℣ My mouth shall speak the praise of the Lord: \* and let all flesh give thanks unto is holy Name.
