## "The PROPER of the MASS for SUNDAYS and HOLIDAYS"

$\sigma$HIS arrangement of the Proprium Missae for Sundays and Holidays is intended for those choirs who find the plainchant from the Graduale beyond their powers of execution; and, secondarily, that those who regularly sing the prescribed melodies, but who may not be able to master everything set down for any particular Mass, may. have something at hand which is easily learnt, and of greater musical interest than a mere recitation of the words on a monotone, or even to a psalm-tone. It is of obligation to sing the proper Introit, Gradual, Offertory and Communion at every High Mass or Miss Cantata. It is better, then, in the writer's opinion, to do well some such simple settings as these, than to labor indifferently through plain-chant, which is often very difficult.
All punctuation marks are intended to be observed by a slight pause, during which breath may be taken if necessary. Redundant commas, from a singer's point of view, have been eliminated. Unless otherwise directed, the music is to be sung briskly throughout in four -part harmony, but without undue haste.

The various crotchets and quavers given at various points (outside the psalm-tones) have relative but not actual time values; e. g. crotchets will receive greater stress and will be dwelt upon longer than quavers. These unbarred passages should be sung smoothly and without detaching them by any kind of break from the preceding reciting notes. The Alleluias, and any other words set to metrical music, should be sung quickly, except when suggestions negativing this are given. The notation of the different psalmtones is taken from the Psalmi in notis, and the "pointing" of the words is according to the "Rules for Psalmody" issued by the Benedictines of Solesmes.
