 - Abbot Pothier's *Graduale* (1883) surprisingly omits the repeat.
 - Dom Mocquereau's *Liber Usualis* (1903) very surprisingly omits the repeat.
 - Pothier's *Editio Vaticana* (1908), the Church's official edition, does include it.
 - Karl Ott's edition provides the full Offertory.
