The Sacred Congregation for Divine Worship at the Vatican announced in a letter to all diocesan bishops on October 3, 1984 that they could grant a faculty for the limited use of the Tridentine Mass in their diocese. The Congregation's letter also stated that for this permission a petition would need to be submitted to the diocesan bishop by those persons interested in participation in a Tridentine Mass and that certain conditions would need to be satisfied.

The petition that was submitted by you satisfies the papal conditions and therefore,

THE ARCHBISHOP OF MILWAUKEE GRANTS YOU PERMISSION TO ATTEND THE ECCLESIASTICALLY APPROVED TRIDENTINE MASS THAT WILL BE CELEBRATED WITHIN THE ARCHDIOCESE OF MILWAUKEE IN THE FUTURE.

Special Notes:

- 1) In order to be admitted to the Tridentine Mass you will need to submit this letter of permission at the entrance of the chapel where the Mass is celebrated.
- 2) This permission is granted to you and is <u>not</u> able to be extended to other friends or family members.
- 3) The Mass will be celebrated in the Tridentine Rite as found in the 1962 Revised Typical Edition of the Roman Missal.
- 4) The first ecclesiastically approved Tridentine Mass will be a Low Mass celebrated at St. Joseph Convent Chapel at 1501 South Layton Blvd. in Milwaukee on Saturday, February 23rd, at 7:00 p.m. (Parking will be available behind the chapel, enter off of 29th and Greenfield Ave.)
- 5) Attendance at this Mass will satisfy the Sunday Mass obligation for the First Sunday of Lent.
