

Now the Schola sings the Proper Antiphon for Magnificat.

The Officiant intones; as soon as the Schola starts to sing, all sit down.

Starting Pitches = D E E B

**C** Ollí-gite \* primum zizáni-a, et alligáte é-a  
in fascículos ad combu-réndum: trí-ti-cum autem congregá-te  
in hór-re-um mé-um, dí-cit Dóminus.

Gather up first the cockle, and bind it into bundles to burn: but the wheat gather ye into my barn, saith the Lord.

All stand for the MAGNIFICAT and ✠ make the sign of the cross

... *until you are incensed*—at which time you sit.

Cantor A intones, men finish verse 1; Ladies sing verse 2; men verse 3; and so on:

1. Magní-ficat \* ánima *mé-a* Dóminus.

2. Et exsultávit **spí**-ritus **mé-** us \* in Dé-o salutáři **mé-** o.

3. Quia respéxit humilitátem ancíllæ **súæ** : \* ecce enim ex hoc beátam me dícant ómnes generatiónes.

4. Quia fécit míhi **má**gna qui **pó**tens est : \* et sánctum *nómen* éjus.

5. Et misericórdia éjus a progénie **in** progénies \* timéntibus éum.

6. Fécit poténtiam in **brá**chio **súo** : \* dispérsit supérbos mente *córdis* **súi**.

7. Depósuit poténtes de **sé**de, \* et exaltávit **hú**miles.

8. Esuriéntes implévit **bónis** : \* et dívites dimísit *in*ánés.

9. Suscépit Israël **pú**erum **súum**, \* recordátus misericórdia *súæ*.

10. Sicut locútus est ad **pá**tres **nó**stros, \* Abraham et sémini éjus *in* **sá**cula.

Stand as Cantor A intones Gloria until asterisk (men finish, then ladies sing verse 12) :

11. Glória **Pá**tri, et **Fí**lio, \* et **Spirítui** **Sán**cto.

12. Sicut érat in princípío, et **nú**nc, et **sé**mper, \* et in **sá**cula *sæculórum*.

Amen.
