

Now the Schola sings the Proper Antiphon for Magnificat.  
The Officiant intones; as soon as the Schola starts to sing, all sit down.

T      Ulit ergo \* paralýticus léctum sú-um in quo jacébat,  
  
magní-fi-cans Dé-um : et ómnis plebs, ut ví-dit, dédit láudem Dé-o.

All stand for the MAGNIFICAT and make the sign of the cross  
... *until you are incensed*—at which time you sit.  
Cantor A intones, men finish verse 1; Ladies sing verse 2; men verse 3; and so on:

1. Magní-ficat \* ánimá mé-a Dóminum.

2. Et exsultávit spí-ritus mé- us \* in Dé-o salutá-ri      mé-o.  
3. Quia respéxit humilitátem ancílla súæ : \* ecce enim ex hoc beátam me  
dícent ómnes generatiónes.  
4. Quia fécit míhi mágna qui pótens est : \* et sánctum nómen éjus.  
5. Et misericórdia éjus a progénie *in progénies* \* timéntibus éum.  
6. Fécit poténtiam in bráchio súo : \* dispérsit supérbos ménte córdis súi.  
7. Depósuit poténtes de séde, \* et exaltávit húmiles.  
8. Esuriéntes implévit bónis : \* et dívites dimísit inánes.  
9. Suscépit Israël púerum súum, \* recordátus misericórdia súæ.  
10. Sicut locútus est ad pátres nóstros, \* Abraham et sémini éjus *in sácula*.

Stand as Cantor A intones Gloria until asterisk (men finish, then ladies sing verse 12) :

11. Glória Pátri, et Fílio, \* et Spirítui Sáncto.  
12. Sicut érat in princípicio, et núnc, et sémpér, \* et in sácula sáculórum.  
Amen.  
Repeat antiphon.
