HOLY WATER USES

The Epiphany Water is very special Holy Water that has - as those of you who attended know - one of the longest blessings in the Ritual. In fact, it is an intense exorcism. Having the opportunity to have some of it for your homes raises the question of uses: What can you use Holy Water for?

It is a sacramental - that is, an exterior sign of an interior grace. By it our souls are cleansed of sin. Through extension of that cleansing it could also serve to help us as a bodily remedy, and it is not uncommon to have miracles from the

use of Holy Water. Being exorcised, it is vehemently hated by the devil. In an exorcism it is used to sprinkle the oppressed person so as to cause the devil more pain than he endures in hell. (He ends up leaving the possessed person when he realizes that he will suffer less in hell.) As a general rule he avoids locations where the water has been sprinkled.

Here are some ideas for its use:

- ◆ Have a holy water fountain at your front door, and bless yourself before leaving or entering your home.
- ◆ Sprinkle a little on the ground at a cemetery to remit the sins of the souls in purgatory and ask that their sufferings be mitigated.
- ◆ Sprinkle around your home to ward off the Evil One.
- ◆ Sprinkle in the rooms of your children if they have nightmares.
- ◆ Have some at your office desk and bless yourself from time to time.
- ◆ Bless yourself with it before praying the family Rosary.
- ◆ Parents can use it to bless their children.
- ◆ Carry a little with you in your purse or car.

You may hear it said that Holy Water can be multiplied by adding less than half. That is said based on a principle that if a blessed object is less than half broken, it can be repaired without losing its blessing. Holy Water shouldn't be treated like a kind of concentrate formula that can be multiplied ad infinitum.

As a general rule, get as much Holy Water as you will use. Don't hoard more than you use, and if you use more than you have, get more!
