We tend to make ourselves the standard in many things, partly because we have to live with ourselves all the time.


But if we find another person to be "a fool", that person probably sees something in us that they find foolish as well - probably not the same thing or aspect, but definitely something, and more than likely something much worse.

No, we are not the standard by which all else is measured. No, we are not the center of the creation. We need to treat others as God treats them.


He treats each with the same level and fairness. He has a singular love for each person.

MAKE A PLEDGE!







The Founders Campaign is to raise money to purchase our future church.
