A THOUGHT FOR SUNDAY

One thing that has always popped out at me each year when we hear this Gospel is how strange it seems that the guests would actually kill that servants that were inviting them to the feast!

It's even understandable that maybe they don't want to go - which in itself is the whole point of the parable: why wouldn't you want to go to the free feast? However why kill the messenger?

For as strange as it is - even though it seems to be an unnecessary extreme tangent in the story - sadly it is very true.

For as little sense as it makes, it seems that the World has continued to kill Catholics just because they are Catholics since the very first followers of Our Lord - most of whom were killed.

And it continues today with ISIS, and in Vietnam, in many places, more often than they care to tell us and much more than we know about.

Why is it that the Truth is persecuted? Why kill someone for their belief? Is Truth such a horrible thing that it needs to be exterminated at all cost? If God wants to invite you to the Banquet, why kill the messenger?

It is hard to explain evil - it rarely makes sense (because it has no Truth). However blessed is he who can die, knowing that he is merely being born to Life. What greater honor can there be? What more glorious way to begin Eternity and enter the Kingdom? What surer way to follow in the footsteps of The Master?
