Google the complete indices of these various hymnals, and see whether you agree that—at their core—they are basically the "ADOREMUS-50." (see below)

However, the *New Westminster Hymnal* (1940), the *Saint John Brébeuf Hymnal* (2018), and the *New Saint Basil Hymnal* (1958) are primarily Roman Catholic.
